### **President's Project: Teenage Meeting Point for Tod's Piece**

I refer to a conversation which I had a few weeks ago with the Town Clerk regarding the above subject. It is the tradition of this club that each year the incoming President selects a personal project for their year in office which runs from July to the following June. It so happens that this year we celebrate the centennial of Lions International and as this year's President of the Lions Club of Rutland I want to do something special to celebrate this remarkable achievement of our international association whilst also recognising that our own club has been in existence for some 42 years in the county.

The project which I have chosen is therefore intended to meet certain selection criteria:

- Something that recognises our **community involvement**
- Something that can be a **permanent reminder of Rutland Lions**
- Something that adds to or improves **our local environment**
- Something that will **benefit young people**
- Something that will be a fitting tribute to **100 years of Lionism**

At a meeting of the Lions Club of Rutland held on 18<sup>th</sup> October the members agreed that I can now approach Uppingham Town Council with an offer to provide you with the sum of **£5000 to provide a Teenage Meeting Point** to be located in a suitable position adjacent to the skateboard park on Tod's Piece. It is the view of my members that this particular part of Tod's Piece is rapidly becoming a valuable community area and is a well-used and popular meeting point for young people but they have nowhere under cover which they can call their own. This will be the largest project ever initiated by a President of this club.




