- 365/19** 1. **Attendance register and apologies for absence**

- 366/19** 2. **Declaration of Members Interests and Requests for Dispensation:** None
- 367/19** 3. **Minutes of the Amenities Committee held on 22nd January 2020**
Resolution: It was proposed by Cornelius Vincent-Enright, seconded by Liz Clarke and unanimously agreed that these be approved.
- 368/19** 4. **An opportunity for the public to speak.**

- 369/19** 5. **Receive an update on progress on FCC grant.** The Assistant Clerk informed the Committee that the Clerks office are preparing a publicity plan for FCC Communities and have issued a PR to local press.
- 370/19** 6. **Consider instructing the Clerk to raise Highway Concerns with Rutland County Council for the following:**
- a) **Stockerston Road – traffic and parking concerns. Resolution:** Proposed by Stephen Rozak and seconded by Richard Reeve to accept Rutland Parking Services solution and request single yellow lines (8am-5pm) to the north side of the road and double yellow lines to the south. Unanimously agreed
 - b) **Queens Road – traffic congestion and parking concerns. Resolution:** Alec Crombie proposed UTC contact Spire Homes regarding creation of parking spaces. Seconded by Lucy Lewin. 6 in Favour 1 against.
 - c) **Leicester Road – parking concerns. Resolution:** Proposed by Richard Reeve to defer to Full Council, seconded by Stephen Rozak and unanimously agreed.
 - d) **Newtown Road – road not wide enough where it meets Stockerston Road and Parking Concerns. Resolution:** Proposed by Peter Rees to defer to Full Council. Seconded by Stephen Rozak and unanimously agreed.

- 371/19** 7. **Consider a Bus Stop Review (referred from January Amenities Committee meeting).**
Resolution: Proposed by Richard Reeve to refuse the RCC bus stop plan as it would result in loss of mature trees to Tod's Piece with no tangible benefit to the town. Seconded by Liz Clarke and unanimously agreed.
