(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE)

Leamington Terrace

Parish of Uppingham CP Order 2019

Rutland County Council District Council ('the Council') has powers under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') to make traffic regulation orders affecting the adopted highway within the County of Rutland.

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council now proposes to make an order entitled the Rutland County Council District Council (Temporary Diversion of Vehicular Traffic) Leamington Terrace Parish of Uppingham CP Order 2018 as the Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed on or near the road.

The effect of the order will be that during the dates and times specified below all lawful traffic will be prohibited from proceeding along the length of road known as Leamington Terrace and the public footpath E304, from Leamington Terrace through to School Lane

The Closure is to enable Tarmac to undertake tarmacking works on the road and footpath on behalf of Rutland County Council.

The duration of the Closure shall be for a maximum period of six months from 21st February 2019 or until the works are completed.

It is anticipated the works will take 22 hours. The closure shall come into force when the appropriate signs and diversion route are erected on site.

The duration of the Closure shall be as follows: from 21st February 2019 to 22nd February 2019

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.
